Alex is 23 years old and comes to us from Florida

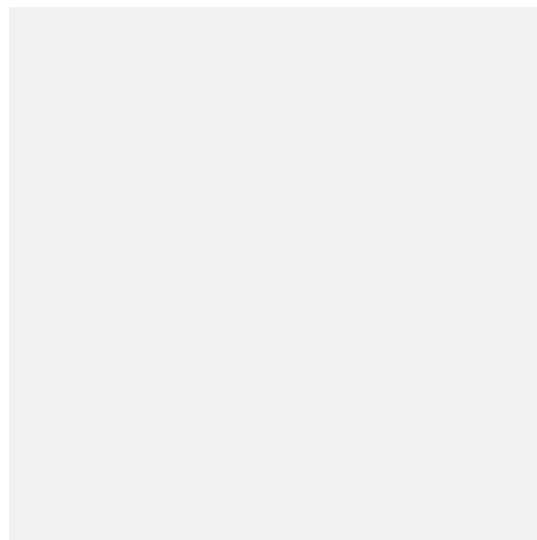
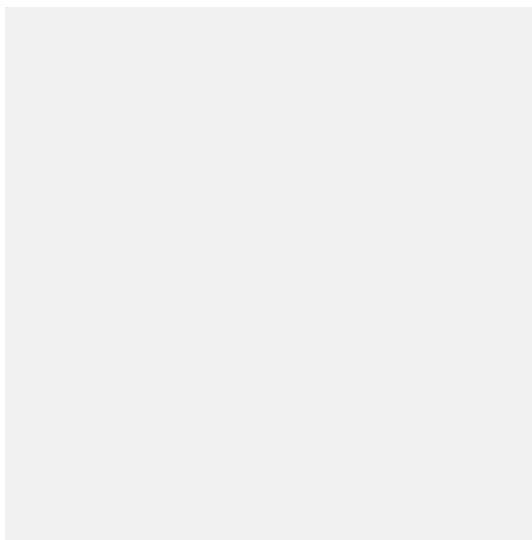


Kedrick is 21 years old and is local from Huntsville
